**\*Internship:** All MPH-Health Policy students are required to complete a professional internship in health policy during their course of study. Students must complete a minimum of 25 credit hours in the MPH-Health Policy curriculum and obtain the approval of the Senior Associate Dean before enrolling in the internship program. Most health policy internships consist of a 13-week, full-time paid placement with a private or public health organization or agency during the final spring semester of each student's final year of academic course work. Other timing is possible as will be the case for MPH/JD students. The HMP faculty make placements that match individual student's experience and career interests with the nature and preferences of available placement sites each year.
