1. Internship: All MHA students are required to complete a professional internship in health services management during their course of study. Students must complete a minimum of 25 credit hours in the MHA curriculum and obtain the approval of the Senior Associate Dean before enrolling in the internship program. Most health administration internships consist of a 13-week, full-time paid placement with a private health provider or other health care organization during the summer prior to each student's final year of academic course work. Placements are made by the MHA faculty who match individual student's experience and career interests with the nature and preferences of available placement sites each year.
2. All MHA/MBA students must register for HMP-591: Health Management and Policy Rounds each semester. Students must attend three of the four sessions presented each semester to received a passing grade.
