***Internship:** All MHA students are required to complete a professional internship in health services management during their course of study. Students must complete a minimum of 25 credit hours in the MHA curriculum and obtain the approval of the Senior Associate Dean before enrolling in the internship program. Most health administration internships consist of a 13-week, full-time paid placement with a private health provider or other health care organization during the summer prior to each student's final year of academic course work. Placements are made by the MHA faculty who match individual student's experience and career interests with the nature and preferences of available placement sites each year.

¹ Students who have not satisfactorily completed at least a 3 credit hour course in college-level finance and a 3 credit-hour course in college-level economics (i.e., 6 credit hours total) must take HMP-504, Fundamentals of Economics and Finance. In addition, it is highly recommended that students, who have not earned at least a "B" in their prior economics or finance course work, take HMP-504 the fall of their first year in the MHA program. In all these cases, HMP-542 should be taken in the second year in place of an elective.

² All MHA students must register for four semesters of HMP-591: Health Management and Policy Rounds. Although four presentations are given each semester, students are required to attend only three of these to receive a passing grade.
