

Health Educator I/II

Position Description: Bureau of Environmental Epidemiology

The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, Bureau of Environmental Epidemiology has an opening for a Health Educator I/II. This position will be located in Jefferson City, and will be part of the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention program. This is a responsible position working with minimal supervision. Duties of this position include:

- Develop and distribute a newsletter for local health agencies and others as appropriate.
- Develop and implement statewide outreach programs to be used promote lead poisoning prevention.
- Develop or revise lead poisoning prevention educational materials as needed for use by health agencies, programs, and other pertinent organizations.
- Distribute educational materials to health agencies, general public, and physicians upon daily requests.
- Coordinate exhibits and events assuring resources such as Leadosaur costume and exhibit boards are updated and available for use by requesting agencies.
- Maintain sufficient quantity of educational materials for distribution are in stock at the DHSS warehouse.
- Maintain up-to-date information on the Department web page.
