

## **Environmental/ Public Health Position Available (PT)**

### **Summary**

Area Resources for Community and Human Services (ARCHS), one of 26 Community Partnerships for the State of Missouri, has received funding from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Office of Environmental Justice for the St. Louis Agencies and Communities Against Toxics (SLACAT) community partnership.

SLACAT will provide leadership to Greater St. Louis residents and small businesses that will educate and train participants about risk exposure from hazardous products, reducing health risk from toxic exposure and increasing knowledge about proper disposal.

This is a three year contractual position, part-time flexible hours.

### **Requirements**

A Bachelors degree in a science field or a combination of equivalent course and work experience. A graduate student in environmental or public health with experience on social justice issues is a desirable candidate. The use of a personal vehicle is required.

- Ability to work effectively in environmental justice communities and provide leadership to achieve set outcomes.
- Ability to manage a technical partnership.
- Ability to effectively communicate both oral and written environmental and public health information to a diverse community.
- Work independently on a results driven project.
