

GRADUATE RESEARCH ASSISTANTSHIPS

The Department of Horticulture, Forestry and Recreation Resources and the Community Health Institute at Kansas State University seek applicants to fill graduate research assistantship positions at the MS or PhD level. Applicants will join a team of scientists specialized in horticulture, kinesiology, statistics, and human nutrition working on a USDA funded "school gardens for health" research project. Applicants may choose to earn their degree in various disciplines including horticulture, kinesiology, and human nutrition. Qualifications are a BS or MS in horticulture or related area, kinesiology, human nutrition, or related behavioral sciences, preferably with experience with youth, extension programs, or community programs. Screening will be ongoing and continue until suitable candidates are found. Applications will be accepted until the positions are filled. Stipends will begin at \$15,000 for MS and \$18,000 for PhD. Graduate research assistants are considered Kansas residents for tuition and fees.
